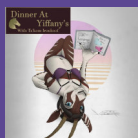

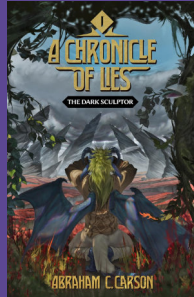

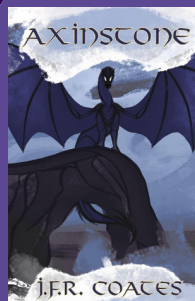

I first read Televassi's work in the anthology *Gods with Fur* and I've been hooked ever since. Televassi has appeared in many anthologies, such as *Dogs of War II* and *Dissident Signals*, and earned a Coyotl award for their story *To Your Own Defenses*, which is also a story in the *In the Light of the Dawn* anthology. They currently write for the visual novel *Conway* and are working on their first novella. I recommend A 'Good' Raid and *Stranded* on their SoFurry page.

A friend introduced me to Faora's online novel *Interwoven*, which is one of the most compelling works I've found on a furry site thus far. I highly recommend checking out this dramatic tale of a tiger prince and a hyena commoner grappling with being pulled apart by their duties to their kingdom. Faora also appeared in short story anthologies, such as *Dissident Signals*, and is working on a massive visual novel project called *Void Dreaming*, illustrated by Vallhound.

Another writer I was introduced to by a friend. Ty Fox has a novel coming out soon at Fenris Publishing called *Gravitational Pull*, which is the story of a gay wolf falling in love while trying to navigate their complicated, and often traumatic, life. I read an early version and can't wait to see the full publication. Ty has also appeared on The Voice of Dog podcast, with *An Alien in our Midst*, a story about a student struggling to understand their asexuality.

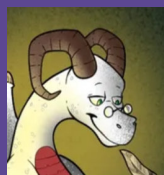
NightEyes is a long-time writer who appears in many short story anthologies. His novel *Scars of the Golden Dancer* is one of the first furry books I ever read, and is a great intro to furry lit. He has also published *Gnoll Tales*, an anthology of short stories starring gnolls, *Knotty Works*, an erotic anthology, and *Therianthropic Dreams*, which features poems from the course of his life. He is currently working on a vampire romance novel that I'm absolutely hyped to read.
